



People Powered Food Drive 2026 Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Where are the food collection sites?

Food donations can be dropped off at the following locations:

- **Christ Episcopal Church**, Columbia, MD
- **Grace Episcopal Church**, Elkridge, MD

Please **text 443-741-1060** when dropping off donations. You may also contact us to arrange a scheduled delivery.

Are there any age restrictions for participating?

No. Everyone is welcome to participate. However, **participants under 18 must be accompanied by a supervising adult.**

Can we accept regular (non-gluten-free) food items?

Yes. While SAFE focuses on gluten-free and allergy-friendly foods, **non-gluten-free and non-peanut-free items** will be sent to our partner, the **Howard County Food Bank**. All donations are carefully reviewed before placement on SAFE shelves.

What if I'm not comfortable collecting food from others?

That's completely fine! You can:

Can we accept non-food items?

Yes. SAFE accepts **in-kind donations** that support our pantry and outreach efforts. However, **all non-food donations must be approved in advance** due to storage and handling considerations. Please contact us at info@safefoodpantry.org before accepting or delivering any non-food items.

Can we sort our food collection for you?

Yes, and we appreciate your help! If it is **safe for you** (based on your own food allergies), you may sort items into separate bags:

- Non-gluten-free and non-peanut-free items
- Items past expiration
- Items with short shelf life

⚠ Important: Your safety comes first. Please do not sort donations if you have food allergies that could be triggered during handling. SAFE volunteers will always double-check items before distribution.
